OBJECTIVE



To strengthen data-driven policy making in the construction sector by shaping labour policies and sectoral strategies. The project explores how data and digital tools can improve working conditions, skills development, and occupational safety and health (OSH).

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Labour market analysis



- Analyse national data to study key labour market challenges (e.g. undeclared work, subcontracting, wages, compliance with collective agreements)
- Develop indicators to detect critical issues and inform improvements

Skills and training

- Map tools to screen VET courses and skills mismatch
- Assess current and possible use of data to inform planning of VET courses
- Identify and document innovative training practices, including digital solutions



Occupational safety and health



- Examine case studies and tools to prevent accidents and monitor workplace risks
- Identify situations at higher risk using data-based approaches

Knowledge sharing and cooperation

- Organise international seminars and study visits to share findings
- Facilitate exchange and peer learning among stakeholders
